MINISTRIES

Sunday Service Ministries – Our Sunday Eucharist is at 10 AM on Sundays. During the months of July and August, the Eucharist is also celebrated at 8 AM. Service ministries include the role of: acolyte, healer, usher, and lector.

Altar Guild – Members of the Altar Guild prepare the table for the Eucharist. They also care for the sacred vessels and altar linens.

Building and Grounds Committee – This Committee is responsible for the care of our sacred space. This includes: caring for the garden, preparing a repair and maintenance schedule for our buildings, and overseeing repairs and maintenance.

Summer Fair – The Summer Fair in August is one of the major fundraisers of the year. There are many ways to participate in this fun-filled, community-building event, from setting up tables and booths, selling raffle tickets, managing the making and serving of lunch, and much more.

Art & Spirit Auction - The other major summer fundraiser contributes both to St. Mary's outreach fund and to emerging artists who choose to receive 50% of the proceeds for their work. For the first time this year, the auction was entirely online, with viewings of the artwork in St. Mary's Hall as part of the Provincetown Gallery Walk on two successive Fridays in July.

Hospitality Committee – Members of this Committee oversee our coffee hour after services, both on Sundays and for other occasions.

Outreach Committee – The Committee is responsible for allocating our tithe of 10% of all of our income to various organizations which they recommend to the Vestry.

Choir – The St. Mary's Choir sings at the 10 AM Sunday Service and on other occasions when that is possible. There is generally one rehearsal for an hour before the 10 AM Service.

Communications and Technology Committee – Members of this Committee assist in parish communications both online and otherwise.
